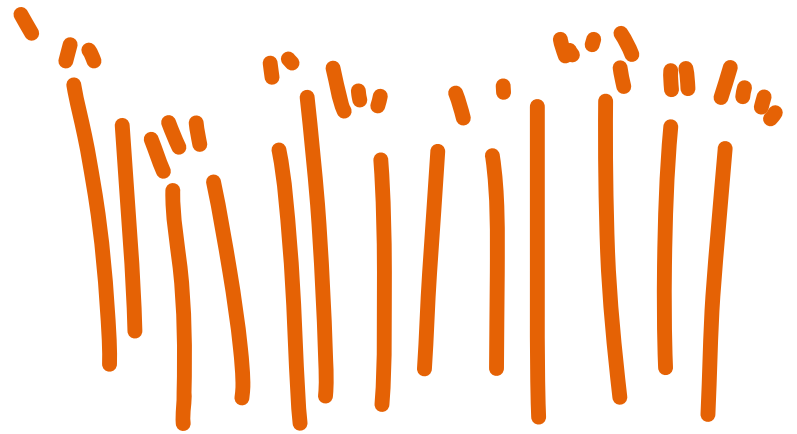


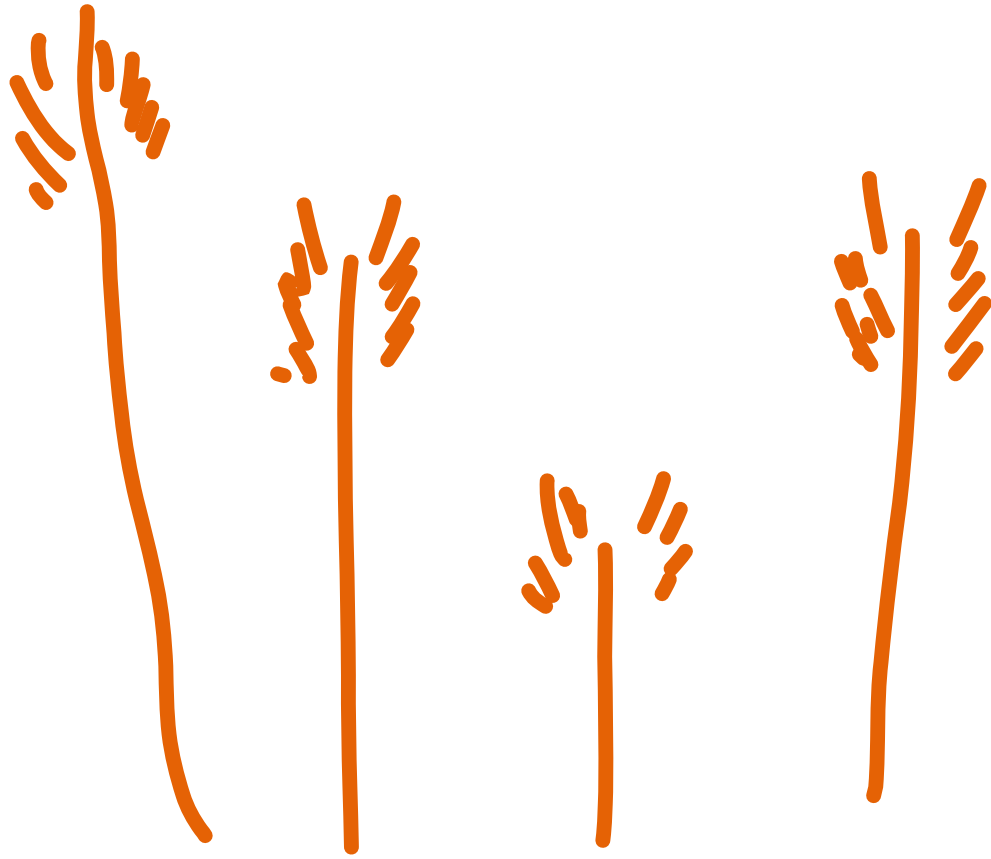
The Excellent Machine

the wheat.



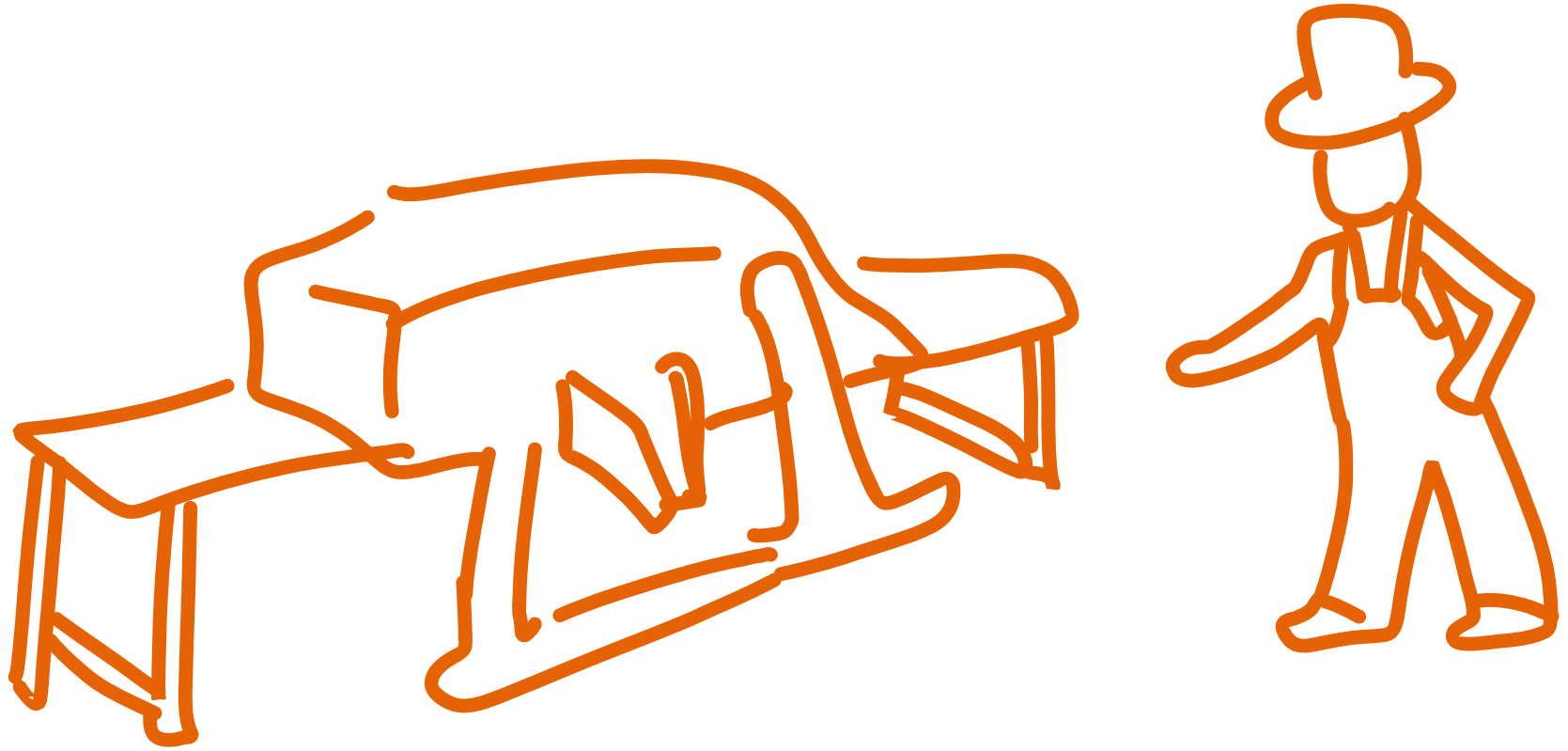
He can thresh with

It can thresh.



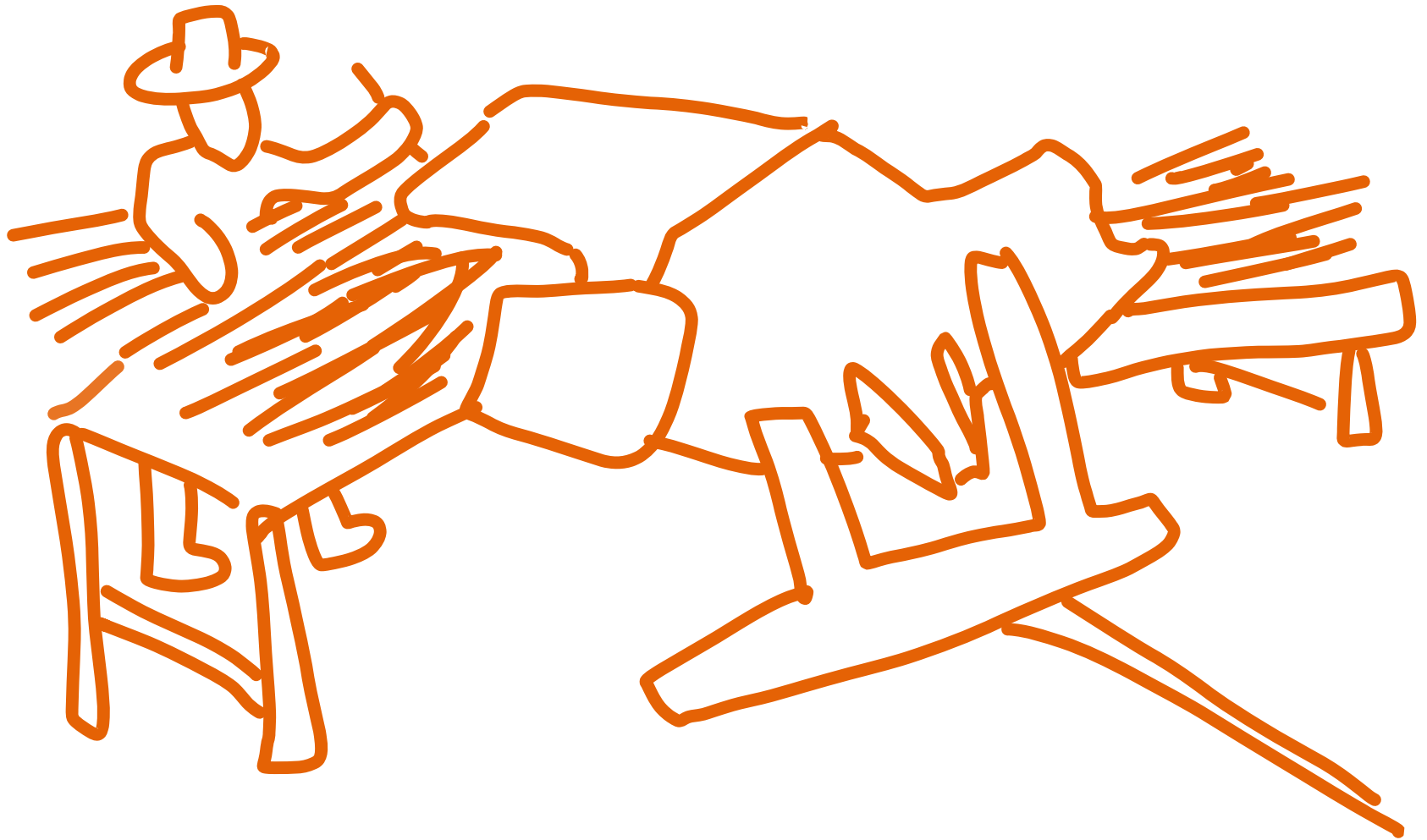
Pa and Uncle Henry

grass in the machine.

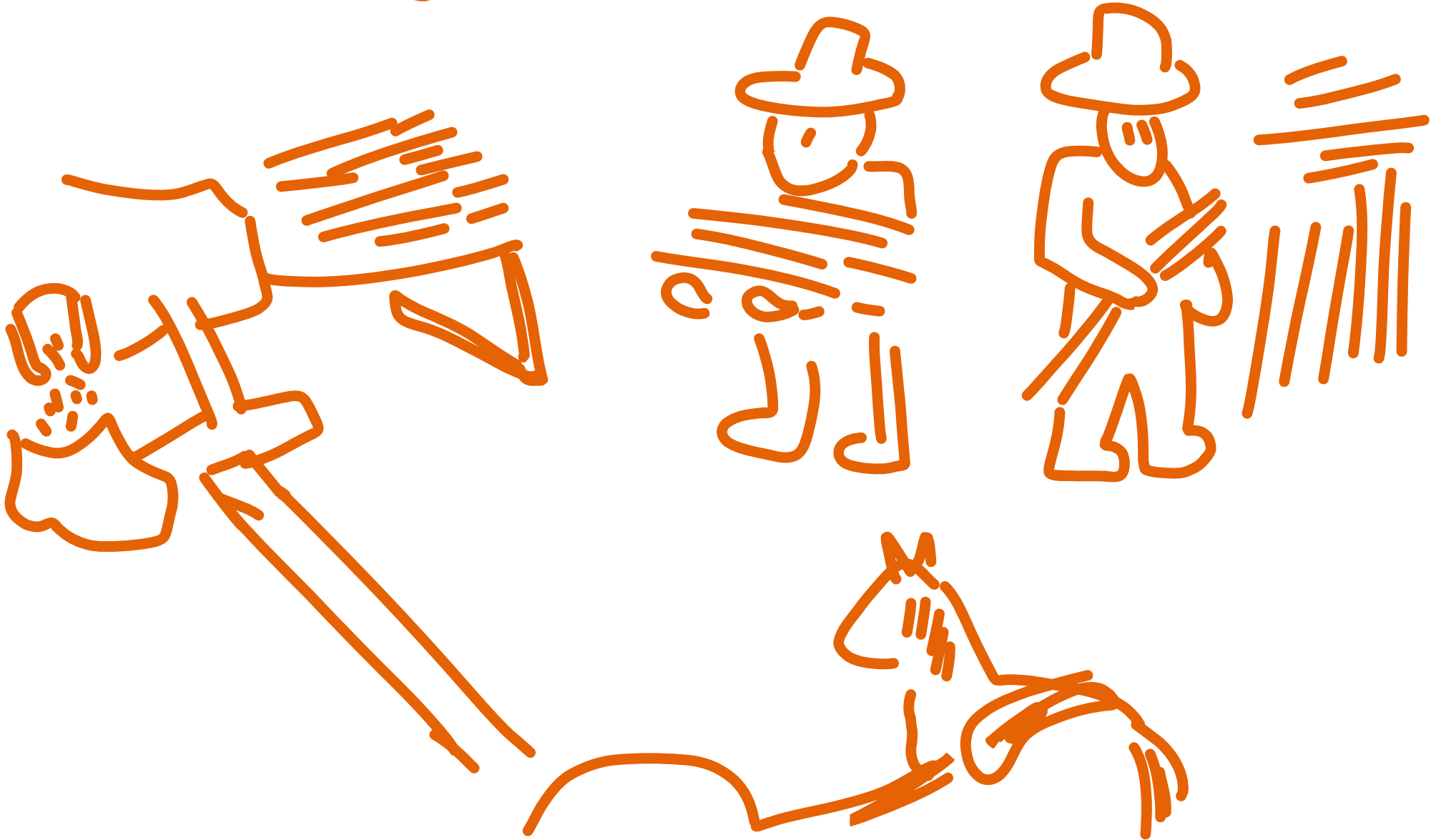


The machine gets

the sack.

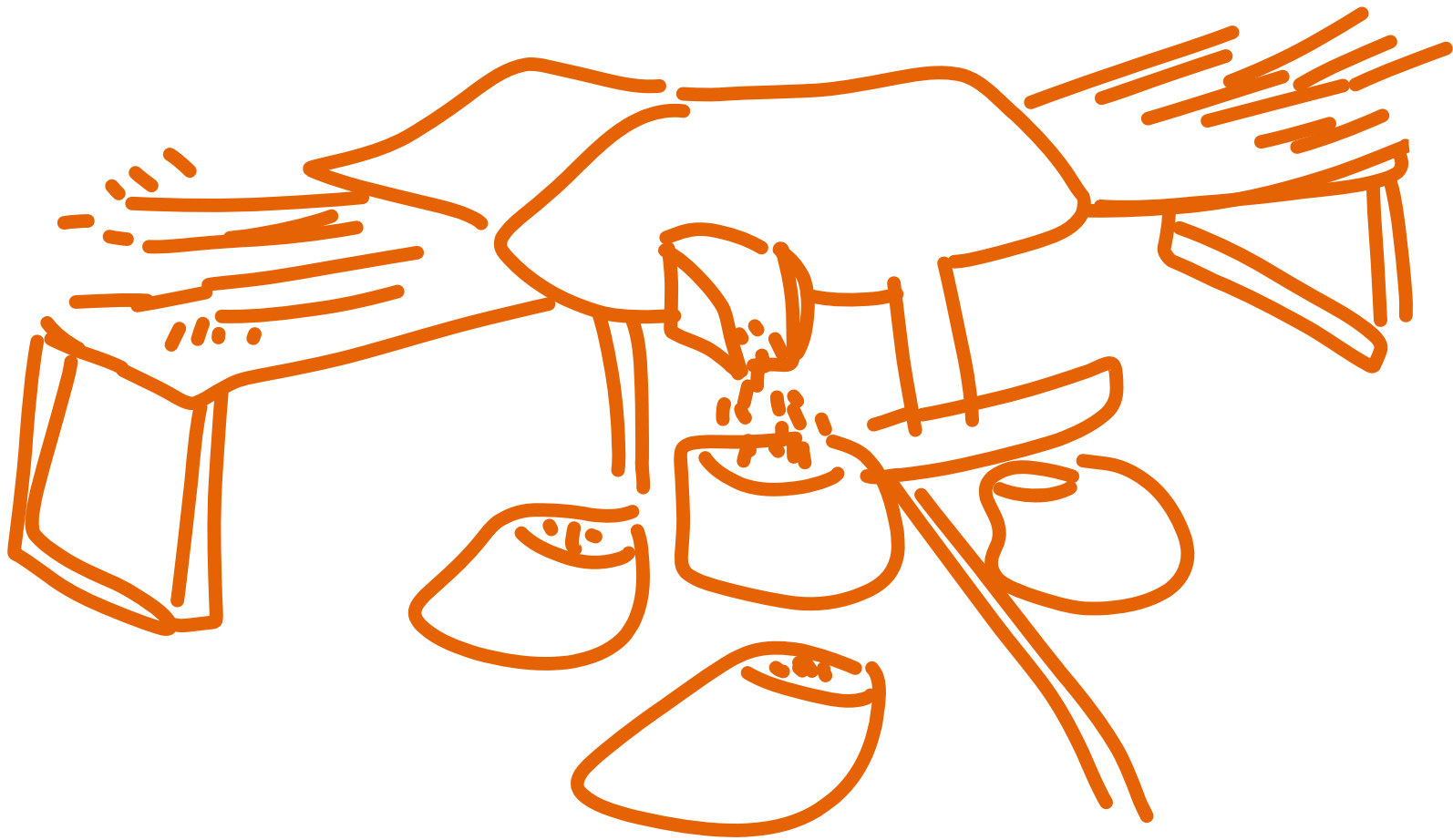
The men stack the
